What we offer

- The Q:Wir Youth Center is a place for queer¹ teenagers, young adults (aged 12–27) and their friends.

We design leisure-based educational activities specifically for our target group and support them in realizing their own ideas. Our work focuses on real-life experiences and participation.

To make our programs accessible to as many people as possible, our space is designed to be barrier-free.

Activities are organized by age group, with some events open to all queer individuals aged 12 to 27 and their friends.



Who we are

Our multi-professional team consists of social workers, educators and youth workers. We follow pedagogical concepts developed by experts and continuously work on improving them.

We place great importance on professional standards and regular training for all employees. This helps us support young people in ways that are appropriate for their age and needs.

A comprehensive child and youth protection policy helps ensure that the Q:WIR Youth Center remains a safe space² for everyone who visits.
